

Remembering Ryan Lohrey

Scholarship will help Shenandoah Students

Friends and family of Marine, Ryan Lohrey, banded together for a campaign and golf outing to fully fund the Ryan Lohrey Memorial Scholarship at the Henry County Community Foundation with a check of \$19,857.61. On hand for the check presentation were Angie Harter, Operations Manager at Tri County Golf Course; Jim and Hilary Casstevens, family friends; Michael and Teresa Lohrey, Ryan's parents; Michelle Leonard, Henry County Community Foundation Development and Marketing Director; Teresa Riggs, retired teacher who had Ryan in school at Shenandoah.

Middletown resident, and U.S. Marine veteran, Kenny Norfleet, was the first to suggest a scholarship in honor of Ryan and his service, and he helped the Lohrey's connect with the Henry County Community Foundation.

According to Hilary Casstevens, "Michael originally asked Jim to help put together a

tournament to start raising money to fund the scholarship. I've helped with several tournaments in the past so I got involved. Angie and I worked very closely together and with the help of all the sponsors, volunteers, and players and we were able to fund the scholarship with this one tournament. Teresa Riggs is also a close friend and helped with planning the tournament as well managed t-shirt sales."

Parents, Michael and Teresa Lohrey, created the Ryan Lohrey Memorial Scholarship Fund at the Henry County Community Foundation to commemorate the life of their son, Ryan Michael Lohrey, HM1 (FMF/MCD/PJ). He was a Special Amphibious Reconnaissance corpsman who died, July 10, 2017, along with his Marine Raider teammates in a plane crash in Mississippi. He was 30 years old.

The Ryan Lohrey Memorial Scholarship will be available to 2019 graduating high school seniors at Shenandoah High School pursuing a two or four year degree in nursing who has financial need. Applications will be available online at the Henry County Community Foundation at www.henrycountycf.org beginning in January 2019.

According to Beverly Matthews, President of the Henry County Community Foundation, "Ryan's scholarship will be available every year in perpetuity, a permanent remembrance of his life, duty and ultimate sacrifice for his community and country. We are honored to remember him."
