

Recently, Boar's Head Provisions Co., Inc. made a large donation of meat, cheese, and various snack items to God's Grain Bin to help local residents in need.

The pantry has experienced a 460% increase in food distribution, from helping 150 families per month to now 700 families per month due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
