How a Scholarship is awarded



CRITERIA

Donors establish criteria to set up a new fund. **HCCF** ensures that each applicant meets the scholarship criteria.

WHAT IS A SCHOLARSHIP?

A scholarship is a grant made to support a student's education, and can be based on variety of criteria (academic, athletics, etc.). HCCF offers scholarships to graduating high school seniors, home-school graduating seniors, current college students, and nontraditional students.

VERIFICATION

Applications are checked for completion by HCCF staff and sent on to committees.

REVIEW

Scholarships are reviewed by committees: They may have their own committee or be reviewed solely by the HCCF Scholarship committee.







AWARDS

Decisions are compiled by HCCF staff. Certificates and award letters are created for Honor Programs. Letters are mailed out to college

If you receive a scholarship, you must send a thank you to HCCF addressed to your scholarship donor. Funds will not be released to your school until a thank you is received at HCCF.

SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENTS

Payments are mailed to the college bursar's office and applied to the recipient's student account. Funds must be used within the academic year for educational expenses (tuition, room and board, books), unless otherwise noted.
