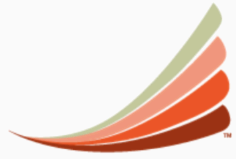

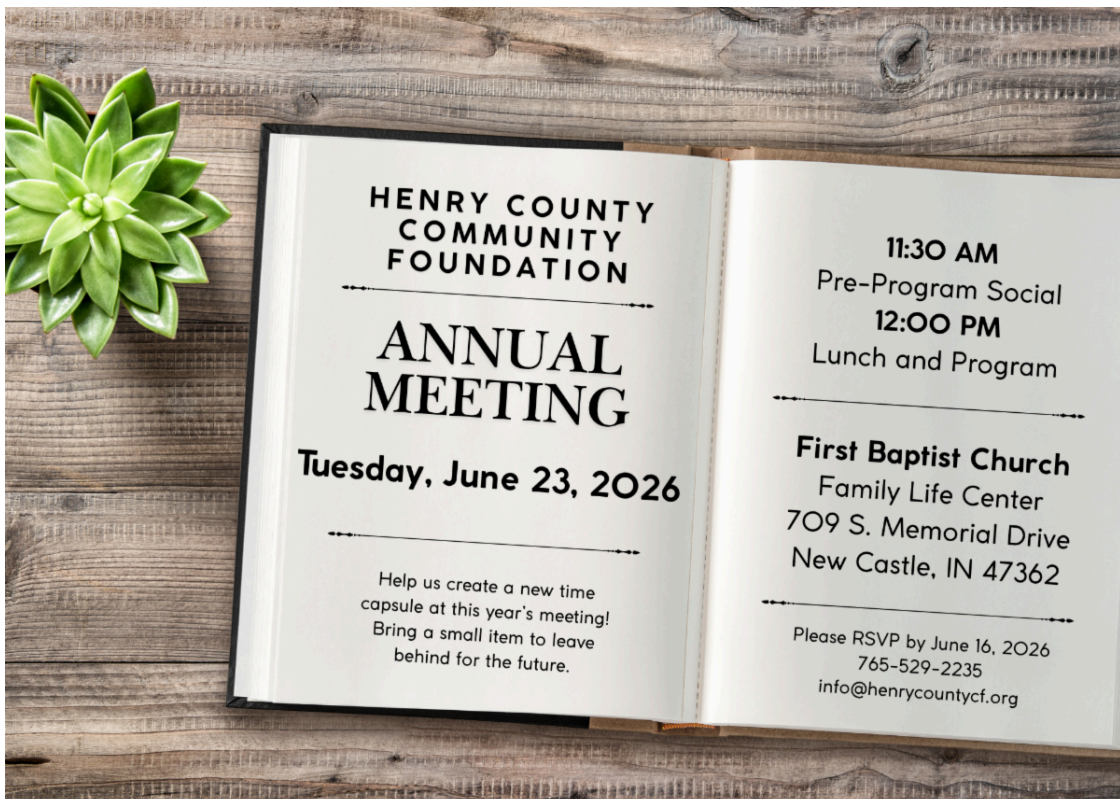


Join Us for Our Annual Meeting!

Summer Intern Job Description

Recreational Trails and Environmental Programs Intern

Anticipated Outcome: As a result of this internship, the student will acquire hands on knowledge of the day-to-day fundamentals of developing and maintaining recreational trails. During the period of this internship, Healthy Communities of Henry County (HCHC) will be commencing the construction of Phase III of the Honey Creek Trail and preliminary work of the Honey bee Electric Path and NC & R RT. As a result, the student will gain invaluable understanding of how such public sector projects are accomplished.

Pay: \$15 per hour for 15 weeks for 15 hours per week – May 1 thru July 31
Benefits: FICA

Supervisor: Jeff Ray, Trails Coordinator, AND SOMEONE ELSE

Typical Duties:

Under the supervision of the Trails Coordinator or other assigned HCHC officials, the intern will be actively engaged in a wide range of trail maintenance tasks, including:

- cutting and removing brush overgrowth along trails
- mowing trail edges and other HCHC property

- installing and maintaining trail signage
- planting trees
- trail cleanup

The Intern will also support the HCHC board of directors through administrative and clerical projects as assigned, including:

- Media and promotional communications
- Website enhancements
- Special projects

In addition to trails related work activities, the Intern may also assist with other HCHC environmental initiatives, such as Henry County Removes Invasive Plant Species and other environmental organizations.

Requisite Skills: The Intern must be able to operate manual and gas-powered equipment, such as chain saws, lawn mowers, hedge trimmers, etc. Must be able to perform physical labor commensurate with the duties listed above. Must have good written and verbal communication skills and basic familiarity with Information Technology. Appropriate training and safety gear will be provided by HCHC.

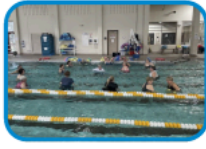

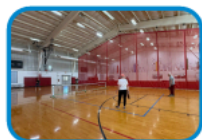
